- Must major in *Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics* (STEM) field
- **Must** currently reside in one of the following locations:

 - *Georgia*
 - *Indiana*
 - *Kentucky*
 - *Miami, FL*
 - *New York*
 - *North Carolina*
 - *Ohio*
 - **Los Angeles metropolitan area**
 - *Texas*
- Have plans to enroll **FULL-TIME** in a degree seeking program at a U.S. accredited institution in the U.S., Puerto Rico, U.S. Virgin Islands or Guam during the **2009-2010** academic year
