- Be a graduating **high school senior** with plans to enroll **full-time** in a **degree-seeking program** at a four-year accredited U.S. institution in the U.S., Puerto Rico, the U.S. Virgin Islands or Guam during the **2010-2011** academic year.
- Have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of **3.00** on a 4.00 scale
- **Must** currently reside in one of the following metropolitan locations: *Baltimore, Boston, Chicago, Detroit, Los Angeles, Miami, Minneapolis/Twin Cities, New York, Philadelphia, Portland, Sacramento, San Diego, San Francisco, Seattle, or Washington, D.C.*
- Willing to **participate** in a **one-year retention program** during the **2010-2011** academic year.
