

Implementation of CDAA

- Agency Secretary's Concurrence with Local Proclamation of Emergency
- Governor's State of Emergency Proclamation
- President's Declaration of a Major Disaster or Emergency



Public Assistance Funding

- Funds are provided through site inspections, and the preparation of Project Worksheets
- Federal funds are provided on a cost sharing basis
 - 75% federal
 - 18.75% state (for applicants eligible under state law)
 - 6.25% local



Building Blocks of PA Eligibility



Hazard Mitigation Funding

- Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP)
- Pre-Disaster Mitigation (PDM)
- Flood Mitigation Assistance (FMA)



Hazard Mitigation Grant Program

- Disaster related
- Governmental agencies and certain private non-profit organizations
- All types of hazards



Pre-Disaster Mitigation

- Annual Appropriation (Started in 2002)
- Nationwide Competition/e-Grant
- State and Local agencies, special districts
- All types of hazards
- Maximum of \$3 million per project grant
- Maximum of \$1 million per planning grant
