




# Eastside Transit Corridor Phase 2

Metro invites you to the next meeting about the Eastside Transit Corridor Phase 2 project. The project seeks to extend the Metro Gold Line east from its current terminus at Pomona Blvd and Atlantic Blvd. Potential north-south route concepts include Arizona Ave and Atlantic Ave in East Los Angeles and Garfield Ave in Montebello.

In November 2014, the Metro Board of Directors directed staff to:

- Eliminate a portion of the proposed aerial alignment along Garfield Ave in Montebello and identify new potential route concepts to reach Washington Blvd.

Potential route concepts include:

- Underground alignment along a portion of Garfield Ave, or
- Atlantic Blvd in East Los Angeles from Atlantic/Pomona south to Washington Blvd\*, or
- Arizona Ave in East Los Angeles from 3rd St south to Washington Blvd\*

\*Profile has not been determined (aerial, street level, underground)

- Conduct additional technical work to address comments received by partner agencies regarding **SR-60 alternative**
- Explore the potential for operating both proposed alternatives (**SR-60 to City of South El Monte** and **Washington Blvd to City of Whittier**)
