Bell

Improvements to Gage Avenue in the City of Bell, including modernization and synchronization of signals, repaving and widening. \$8,200,000

Bell Gardens

Ford Park Transit Center and Park and Ride, including environmental review, engineering, and design of public transportation facilities. \$850,000

Bell Flower

Design and construct pavement restoration and raised landscaped center medians on Bellflower Boulevard from the Bellflower South City Limit to Artesia Boulevard. \$2,000,000

Sit, environmentally review and design a new bicycle and pedestrian bridge across the San Gabriel River within the city of Bellflower. \$960,000

Acquire property, design, and construct a regional transit center in the City of Bellflower. \$9,625,600

Design and construct restoration of Clark Avenue from Artesia Boulevard to Alondra Boulevard in the City of Bellflower. \$2,500,000

Design and construct pavement restoration of Woodruff Avenue from Beach Street to Alondra Boulevard in the City of Bellflower. \$2,000,000

Commerce

Plan, design, and reconstruct Garfield Avenue from Ferguson Drive to Gage Avenue. \$3,525,000

Plan, design, and reconstruct Eastern Avenue from Stevens Place to Randolph Street. \$4,000,000

Plan, design and reconstruct Telegraph Road from Camfield Avenue to Church Street. \$5,600,000

Cudahy

Construct, plan, design and engineer the Asphalt Concrete Overlay Project on Wilcox Street. \$490,000

Downey

Construct a raised, landscaped median and install a reclaimed water main and associated irrigation system along Telegraph Road in the Cities of Downey and Pico Rivera. \$3,252,480

Reconstruct, rehabilitate, resurface and widen Lakewood Boulevard between 5th Street and Telegraph Road. \$10,400,000

Install fiber optic communications infrastructure and video detection cameras to link 15 signalized intersections along Paramount Boulevard to the City's Traffic Management Center for enhanced traffic signal operations, maintenance, and surveillance purposes. \$1,952,000

Reconstruct approximately 0.26 miles of roadway along Paramount Boulevard between Florence Avenue and Lubec Street, including the reconstruction of existing improvements to ADA standards and the miscellaneous repair of existing concrete surfaces. \$987,348

Reconstruct approximately 1.6 miles of roadway along Firestone Boulevard between Old River School Road and Nash Avenue in the City of Downey, including the reconstruction of existing improvements to ADA standards and the miscellaneous repair of existing concrete surfaces. \$2,438,060

Construct a raised, landscaped median and install a reclaimed water main and associated irrigation system along Paramount Boulevard in the City of Downey. \$4,230,750

Rehabilitation of State Street. \$1,820,000

Rehabilitation of Stafford Avenue in Huntington Park. \$840,000

Rehabilitation of Maywood Avenue in Huntington Park. \$560,000

Rehabilitation of traffic signal systems at Maywood and Randolph and at Slauson and Bickett in Huntington Park. \$560,000

Los Angeles

Downtown Los Angeles CNG Transit Fueling Facility. \$4,880,000

Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension Corridor Great Safe Neighborhood Streets. \$5,000,000

To conduct environmental review and alternative analysis for the Downtown Los Angeles Streetcar system. \$2,000,000

To finance and construct a vehicle maintenance, inspection and storage facility for the Downtown Los Angeles streetcar system. \$8,000,000

To finance and construct one phase of ongoing, multi-phase infrastructure improvements and pedestrian enhancements in the Historic Broadway Theatre District, a National Register Historic District in Downtown Los Angeles. \$4,500,000

Maywood

Design and construction of roadway and pedestrian improvements to the intersection of Slauson Avenue and Atlantic Boulevard, including one block in each direction. \$1,080,000

Vernon

Rehabilitate and reconstruct segments of Washington Boulevard, Downey Road, Slauson Avenue, Boyle Avenue, and Fruitland Avenue in the City of Vernon. \$4,000,000

Para-transit Services

Integrate Access Services' 70,000 customers into the Regional Los Angeles County Transit Access Pass (TAP) smart card system by funding the purchase of fare equipment and other necessary items. \$1,865,000

Procure Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) clean air vehicles and fueling infrastructure for Los Angeles County para-transit fleet. \$4,400,000

California Regional Rail Authority

Rail Safety Infrastructure Project for Metrolink Positive Train Control Safety Improvements. \$2,000,000

Gateway Cities Council of Governments

Develop programs and install and monitor air quality monitoring stations in the I-710 Corridor in Southeast Los Angeles County. \$12,000,000

I-5 Joint Powers Authority

Prepare environmental document to analyze widening I-5 to 10 lanes and improve corridor arterials between I-605 and I-710. \$16,000,000

Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority

Plan, design, and construct an approximately two mile direct transit link connecting several light rail lines in operation or in construction, including the Metro Gold Line to Pasadena, the Metro Gold Line to East Los Angeles and/or the Metro Expo Line to Culver City. \$30,000,000

Design, right-of-way acquisition, and constructions of the I-710 Atlantic Boulevard/Bandini Boulevard approaches, ramps, and various improvements to nearby arterials. \$88,000,000

Design and construct pedestrian linkages to the Los Angeles Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension. \$30,000,000

Improve approaches and interchanges on I-605. \$9,000,000
